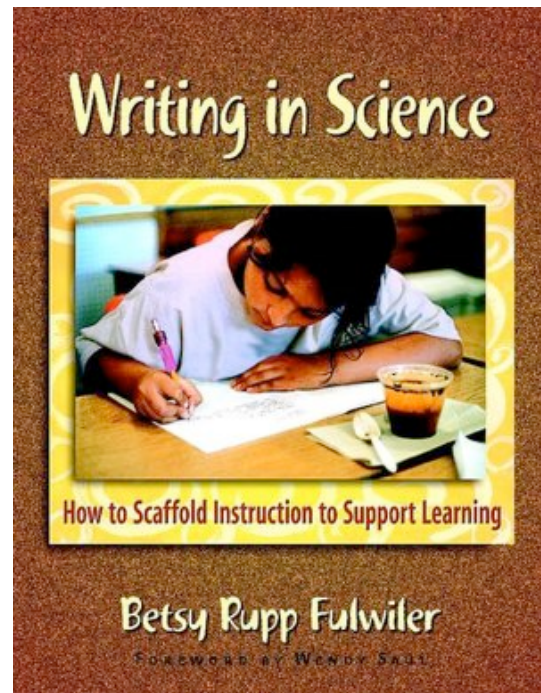
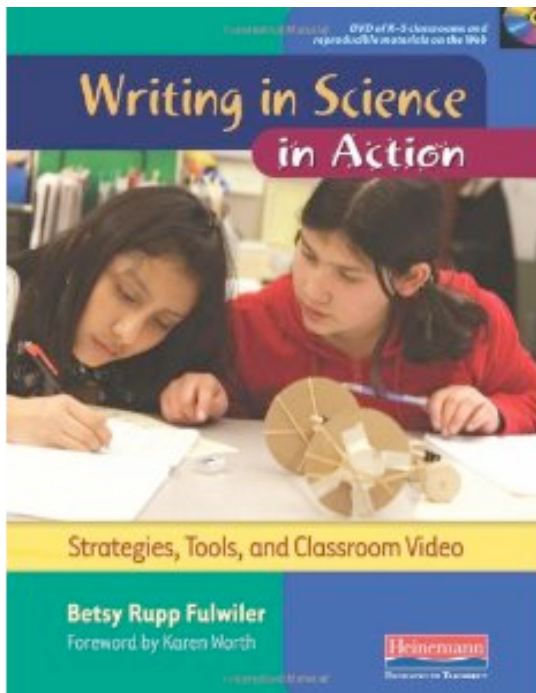


Scaffolding Vocabulary Development in Inquiry Science
